A new study suggests that some websites like Facebook can affect how we understand the happiness of other people.

Students at a university in the US were asked how many friends they had on Facebook. "Well, probably between 350 and 400," said one student. Another student said, "I don't know exactly how many friends I have on Facebook, but I find myself checking it many times a day."

Researchers wanted to know if all that time users spent looking at people on Facebook affected how users saw—not themselves—but other people. They asked 425 students if other people had better and happier lives. Then they asked them how long they had been Facebook users and how many hours a week they spent visiting others' Facebook.

They find the students who spend more time on Facebook are more likely to think that other people's lives are happier and better. This is especially true among students who add more strangers on their Facebook accounts. They're thinking their lives are not as interesting as other people's lives.

A psychologist (心理学家) says it's easy to think that Facebook friends are always very happy because they don't tell people negative (消极的) things on Facebook. They only tell people positive ones. "Don't spend a lot of time just looking at other people's positive things. Share your own and see who your true friends are and who really cares about the things that happen to you," the psychologist also says.

which is basically a hole in the Earth's surface, sends out hot ash, gas, and rocks into the air.

50 They can destroy houses and burn or choke (使窒息) people to death. A volcano in New Zealand called White Island erupted, killing 16 people and injuring many others.

How do volcanoes form? As you may know, the Earth's surface is actually broken up into 17 parts, which are called tectonic plates (构造板块). These plates move around sometimes. 51 But sometimes, a volcano forms instead.

Volcanoes can be either dormant (休眠的) or active. If a volcano is dormant, it is

"asleep". There is little to no risk that it will erupt. <u>52</u> It could erupt at almost any time!

White Island is an active volcano. It is located along the "Ring of Fire", which refers to the chain of volcanoes that circles the Pacific Ocean.

The outside of the volcano has many cracks (裂缝) in it that allow water to get inside. __53_But then, the steam becomes trapped. It has nowhere to go. This causes the volcano to violently (猛烈地) erupt, sending out clouds of superheated steam, hot ash and rocks. Many eruptions occur in this way.
